WHY THIS FILM, WHY NOW A Hidden Giant. A Global Legacy

CIRILO, A Legacy Untold iis a 26-minute documentary short narrated by two-time Grammy winner and actress Ann Nesby that tells the extraordinary story of Cirilo McSween, a Panamanian-born civil rights advocate, pioneering businessman, and international strategist.

From becoming New York Life Insurance's first Black agent in 1957, civil rights activist alongside Dr. Martin Luther King in the 1960s, to helping to orchestrate behind the scenes the return of the Panama Canal to Panamanian control via the Torrijos-Carter Treaties in 1977, to becoming an entrepreneurial success story as a McDonald's franchisee in the 1980s through the 2000s, McSween's life intersected with some of the most pivotal movements of the 20th century.
